### FSMH Families travel to Colonial Williamsburg!



Last weekend third grade students and their families traveled to Colonial Williamsburg in Virginia. On Friday they all met at Jamestown Settlement Museum and had a guided tour that featured American Indian life in early Virginia, boarded a colonial ship, and toured the Jamestown Fort. The next morning, they attended a guided tour of Colonial Williamsburg where they experienced everyday life for a middling Williamsburg family. They also relived the decision of Virginia to declare independence from Britain, and reenacted a real 18th century court case. In the afternoon, two Colonial Williamsburg archaeologists gave the students a behind-the-scenes tour of some archaeological sites, and gave them hands-on experience interpreting the actual artifacts, bones, and seeds from 250 years ago.
