Algebra for Parents

A course to refresh adults on pre-Algebra and Algebra topics that seventh, eighth and ninth grade students encounter including: Integers, sequential patterns, equation solutions, graphing, systems of equations, functions, and multiplying and factoring polynomials. The analysis of the nature of Algebra is explored as well as shared strategies to solve algebraic problems. The course is taught within the experience of the student focusing on real life problem solving in cooperative learning groups. This is not the same way math was taught to us years ago!
