JULIE-ANN WHITELEY GREEN, *soprano*, earned a Bachelor of Arts degree as a double major in Vocal Performance and Music Education from Rowan University (formerly Glassboro State College). She has earned Artists Diplomas from the Mozarteum Academy in Salzburg, Austria, and has studied Italian Opera, Language, Art and Culture at the Florence Voice Seminar in Florence, Italy. Her vocal talents have attained her numerous honors including Encouragement Grant, Marian Anderson Award; Mozarteum Academy Scholarship; and National Winner, Leontyne Price Vocal Arts Competition.

Ms. Green made her New York solo debut at Carnegie Hall in 1992, and was presented in a solo recital at Weill Hall in 1997. Other major venues include cathedrals in London, Paris, Rome, Vienna, St. Petersburg, Moscow, Madrid, and the Mormon Tabernacle. Popular music performances have been with Barry Manilow, Michael Crawford and with Barbra Streisand. Ms. Green has sung with the Opera Company of Philadelphia since 2001, and has performed solo roles in *Porgy and Bess* (Strawberry Woman), and *Il Trovatore* (Inez) as well as their innovative production, the *Hip H'Opera Project*. Her debut with New York City Opera at Lincoln Center was in Richard Danielpour's opera, *Margaret Garner*.

Concert performances of *Porgy and Bess* (Bess, Clara, Serena) and *I Pagliacci* (Nedda) have left audiences mesmerized. Ms. Green made her debut as Aida in the spring of 2008, and has recently sung with Lyric Opera of Chicago and San Francisco Opera in their productions of *Porgy and Bess*. Other recent performances include an appearance with the Allentown Symphony, her debut in the title role of *Tosca*, the Mother in *Amahl and the Night Visitors* and as soprano soloist for the Verdi *Requiem* with the Lancaster Symphony. Ms. Green's next area performance will be with Vox AmaDeus at the Kimmel Center on Friday, April 22nd during the Philadelphia International Festival of the Arts.

Ms. Green is the Director of Fine and Performing Arts at the Friends School in Mullica Hill, New Jersey where she is also the Middle School Chorus director. In addition to her own private studio, she is Director of Arts for Christus Academy in Camden, New Jersey. Ms. Green is currently Music Director at First Baptist Church of Pitman, New Jersey.
